Today she became a stakes winner for the stable that bred the daughter of German sire Lomitas out of French-bred Saralea, who raced for Team Valor before becoming a broodmare for Barry Irwin.

Hasay becomes stakes winner number 10 and won stakes number 14 in 2011 for Team Valor, which leads all partnership groups in the important categories of stakes winners, stakes wins, Graded winners and Graded wins.

Team Valor is, in fact, tied with the stable of Mike Repole for the North American leadership in number of Graded stakes winners (4) and number of Graded stakes wins (7) this season.

In this his 25th year of racing partnerships that he formed, Team Valor CEO Irwin now sees his stable with yearly earnings of \$3,511,123.

Team Valor in 2011 has won 35 races for a winning strike rate of 23.18 percent.

Stakes wins comprise 40 percent of the stable wins in 2011 and 29 percent lifetime.

The stable record for stakes wins is 21 established in 1993. TVI has come close many times in reaching this same number and remains optimistic that it can reach or better its record before the 2011 season goes into the record books.
