Trainer: Rick Mettee, private trainer for Team Valor International. Mexikoma was transferred to Mettee's base at Fair Hill Training Center on September 19.

Bred: in Florida by Hickstead Farm. Jockey: Alan Garcia.

Training: Mexikoma worked 3 times under exercise rider Shav Aizpuru for Mettee before shipping to Santa Anita Park on October 26. In his most recent drill (the only one with blinkers), Mexikoma started off slowly with an opening quarter in :27 and proceeded with

5 more furlongs in 1:00 2/5 to get 7 eighths in 1:27 2/5. He galloped out a mile in 1:40. Steve Haskin of the *Blood-Horse* said this week that he was very impressed upon seeing the colt in the flesh at Santa Anita Park.
